“Disk-Edits” Commitment To Privacy:

“Disk-Edits” uses its best efforts to respect the privacy of its online and in person visitors and customers. To better protect your privacy we provide this notice explaining our privacy practices.

The Information We Collect, and How We Use It:

We collect no personally identifiable information about you when you visit our website unless you choose to provide that information to us.

We may use your personal identifiable information:

- ◆ To provide you with information relating to “Disk-Edits” products and services that may be of interest to you as indicated by you
- ◆ For purposes connected with the operation and administration of “Disk-Edits” accounting
- ◆ Where “Disk-Edits” suspects that fraud or unlawful activity has been, is being or may be engaged in, as required by law.

Web Forms:

We use this information only to complete the order or answer the request. We do not share this information with outside parties except to the extent necessary to complete that order.

We may also use your Personal Data to contact you with newsletters, marketing or promotional materials and other information that may be of interest to you. You may opt out of receiving any, or all, of these communications from us by following the unsubscribe link or instructions provided in any email we send or by contacting us.

How email is Handled:

By sending us an electronic mail message, you may be sending us personally-identifying information. In these cases, we may retain the information as long as necessary to respond to your request or otherwise resolve the subject matter of your e-mail. Such addresses are not used for any other purpose and are not shared with outside parties.



Web Page Visits:

For each HTTP request received, we collect and store only the following information:

- ◆ the date and time
- ◆ the originating IP address
- ◆ the URL of the referring page (if provided by the browser)
- ◆ the object requested (such as a graphic image)
- ◆ completion status of the request
- ◆ pages visited

We can use this information to measure the number of visitors to the different areas of our sites, and to help us make our sites more useful to visitors. This information is never used for any other purpose.

Our Commitment To Data Security:

To prevent unauthorized access, maintain data accuracy, and ensure the correct use of information, we have put in place appropriate physical, electronic, and managerial procedures to safeguard and secure the information we collect online. Unfortunately, no data transaction over the Internet can be guaranteed as completely secure.
